

# Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan Summary

Stage 1	864' – 861' Implement Blending	74.5%-54%	10%	Only allow 2 days a week for outside watering. Time of day restrictions apply.
Stage 2	861' – 858'	54%-38%	20% total	Only allow 1 day per week for outside watering. Time of day restrictions apply
Stage 3	858' – 854'	38% - 23%	25% total	Only allow Soaker Hoses and Drip Irrigation.
Stage 4	854' and below	23% and below	30% total	Soaker hoses and Drip Irrigation Tuesday and Friday.
<b>Emergency Water Conditions</b> Initiated by acts of God, contamination, main water line issues, etc.	any level	any capacity		Maintain emergency water supply for public safety.

## Stage 1

- A. Achieve 10% reduction in total use.
- B. Unattended landscape watering will be permitted two days a week. Other outside use is permitted.
  - Addresses west of Highway 281 will be Monday and Friday.
  - Addresses east of Highway 281 will be Tuesday and Saturday.
- C. No unattended landscape watering on any day between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm.
- D. Hand watering of landscaping, shrubs, gardens, and grass is permitted anytime.
- E. Soaker Hoses and Drip Irrigation permitted anytime.
- F. Construction must use Reuse.
- G. Implementation of Blending Brazos River Water.

## Stage 2

- A. Achieve 20% reduction in total use.
- B. Unattended landscape watering will be permitted one day a week. Other outside use is permitted.
  - Addresses west of Highway 281 will be Monday
  - Addresses east of Highway 281 will be Tuesday
- C. No unattended landscape watering on any day between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm.
- D. Draining and refilling of Swimming Pools will not be allowed.
- E. Maintaining Swimming Pool levels will be allowed.
- F. Hand watering of landscaping, shrubs, gardens, and grass is permitted before 9 am and after 6 pm.
- G. Soaker Hoses and Drip Irrigation permitted anytime.

## Stage 3

- A. Achieve 25% reduction in total use.
- B. Only outside water use permitted will be Soaker Hose, Drip irrigation and animal use.
- C. Commercial uses not listed will be controlled to the extent directed by the City Manager.

## Stage 4

- A. Achieve 30% reduction in total use.
- B. Soaker Hose and Drip Irrigation permitted on Tuesday and Friday.
- C. Animal use exempt.
- D. Implementation of RO Facilities.

## Emergency Water Conditions

- A. Maintain emergency water supply for public safety.
